
How do I wish to (re-)connect with people that are important to me?


Exercise 2








Today we will talk about ways we can get into contact with others.



But first, we will continue with the story of Sam



Do you remember who is who?







This is how often Sam would like to see those persons.

Jos = Every day



Tessa = 1 time a week



Tony = few times a month



Support worker from the group home = 1 time a month



His neighbours from the farm = few times a year





Sam's support worker has found out that Jos is living in a group home, one hour away from where Sam lives.

She asks Sam to think about how he will be able to see his friend every day?



Sam realizes that he won't be able to visit Jos every day because Jos lives to far away and he himself has difficulties moving around.





Jos is able to take a bus to visit Sam.

This way he can text or even see Jos with facetime every day.


