Activity 3: Which institutions are dealing with my rights' protection?¹

This Activity aims to help AAWID in better understanding the functions of the various institutions from the social security sector in the context of civil rights and social benefits' provision. It is in the format of quiz – three questions three questions with three possible answers. Every individual answer indicates a different institution, as to each of them is added the official logo of the respective institution. The aim is AAWID to learn also to recognize the different institutions by their logos.



Note: Before proceeding with this activity, the educator should observe first the extent to which AAWID is familiar with the various institutions in the social sector and take sufficient time to explain in detail and by using understandable language what the activities of the various institutions are and under what conditions he could benefit from their services.
