Activity 2: The right person for the right activity

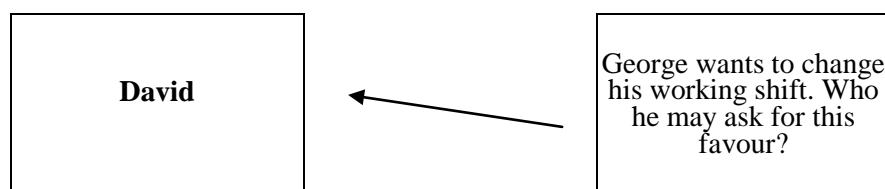
This activity contains two columns – the first one contains the names of some family members, friends, and colleagues of the main character from the previous stories, and the second one contains activities that he intends to do.
